


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Latest Developments

1st Ageing Well International Event – Eindhoven, The Netherlands



The **1**st **International Event of the Ageing** *Well* was held within the AAL Venture Days promoted under the AAL Forum. The AAL Forum gathered over 1.000 participants, some 200-250 of whom attended also the AAL Venture Days-sessions on the 25th and 26th of September.

The AAL Venture Days, organized in collaboration with local and international partners (including the **Ageing***Well* network partners), served as the 1st International Event - ICT for Ageing well Finance Marketplace - the one-stop shop for the ICT SMEs to meet investors.

Focusing on entrepreneurs looking to expand internationally and to gain access to equity investment, the Venture Days paid particular attention to businesses with a specific mix of business characteristics who received coaching to optimize their presentation of their strengths and needs.

Ageing Well Network presented at the UniversAAL Open Day

The **Ageing***Well* Network attended the Open Day of the UniversAAL project (http://universaal.org), on the 8th November 2012, in Krakow, Poland. At this event the objectives and activities of the Network, as well as its achievements so far were presented to participants, who have been invited to become associate members and/or supporters.
